Recognizing the importance of water management in farming, the conference will focus on the "Magel Tyala Shet Tale" scheme initiated by the state government. Agricultural officers and experts will provide guidance on proper water management techniques and crop selection based on available resources. This knowledge will help farmers make informed decisions, leading to better yields and sustainability in farming practices.

4. **Trees for Shade and Cooling:** Banyan, Peepal, and other species provide much-needed shade in urban and rural areas, reducing temperatures.
5. **Agricultural Utility Trees:** Trees such as Sagargota and Shikakai are beneficial for soil fertility and crop growth.
6. **Soil-Binding Trees:** Species like Bamboo and Khair are effective in preventing soil erosion.
7. **Trees for Construction and Furniture:** Sarsav, Teak, and Chandan are useful in building and furniture-making industries.

Udaykal Foundation urges citizens to select trees based on their local environment and utility to maximize their benefits. The initiative also emphasizes preserving biodiversity and protecting endangered species by planting appropriate native trees.


