Udyakal Foundation Distributes Blankets to Katkari Tribal Community in Khopi Village

Date: 22nd December 2018

Udyakal Foundation distributed 50 new blankets to the Katkari tribal community in Khopi village, Bhore Taluka. Khopi is a rural area where around 50 Katkari families live in extreme poverty, surviving on daily wages. With the harsh winter season and mountainous terrain surrounding the village, the cold becomes unbearable, especially at night.

Understanding their difficult situation, Dadaso Pawar, a representative of Udyakal Foundation, brought attention to the plight of the Katkari community. Seeing that many children lacked proper blankets to sleep at night, the foundation decided to provide them with new blankets to help them cope with the severe winter.

The blanket distribution was conducted with the help of local friends from Khopi village, who also interacted with the residents to understand their struggles. Udyakal Foundation remains committed to supporting underprivileged and needy communities and expressed gratitude to everyone who contributed to making this initiative successful.



Gandhi - Understanding and Misunderstanding: Book Distribution and Lecture at Amalner

Udaykal Foundation Honored at Drought Conference, Expands Tanda Reading Project




